# **RECURRING GIVING IMPACT**



### \$10 Per Month

- 5 months funds a small business in Sri Lanka such as vegetable growing or banana cultivation.
- 8-12 months funds small business in Bangladesh such as growing ginger or raising goats.



- 2-4 months funds poultry project or bakery in Sri Lanka.
- 5-8 months starts a small business in the Philippines like pig raising, school supplies store, or sari-sari (variety) store.

## \$100 Per Month

- 5 months funds a small business in Myanmar such as pig farming, poultry farming, or growing papaya.
- 7 months funds a fishery business in Cambodia or a business in Laos such as a postage company, motorcycle mechanic, laundromat, vegetable garden, or tree nursery.
- 10 months funds an agriculture business in Thailand like coffee, avocado, mango, or growing mango.

### \$250 Per Month

- 4-6 months funds a business in Kenya such as an M-Pesa money exchange shop, selling bananas, or growing maize.

#### \$500 Per Month

#### \$2000

- Funds a hand dug well in Cuba used to irrigate a farmer's crops.
- Start a new program in Burkina Faso with 5-10 initial participants.
- Funds a Rickshaw project for a pastor in Bangladesh.
- Funds a pilot project for 2-4 high school grads to start businesses in Bangladesh.

# \$4000

- Fund a fish pond project in Bangladesh providing livelihood for 3 families.
- Fund a citronella business in Indonesia providing livelihood for 3 families.



# \$5000

- Funds a new program in SE Asia like Thailand, Laos, Myanmar, Vietnam, Cambodia, or Indonesia. Funding would allow 6-8 initial participants.
- Fund a medium sized cattle farm for a Pastor in Bangladesh.



## \$10,000

- Funds a pilot poppy substitution project in Myanmar helping 12-15 initial participants to find a morally acceptable and financially sustainable solution to support their families.

- Expand program in India to reach 10 more people every year.



## \$15,000

• Expand Pakistan program to reach 30 more participants every year. Right now they are at 70 participants with a goal of 100 total participants this year.
